

## Minibeast parts

Adapted from Sharing Nature with Children (Joseph Cornell)

1. Think about the animals found in the compost bin. After a discussion divide into groups of 4 – 5 children.
2. The smaller groups should think of one creature found in the compost bin and think about what it looks like and how it moves. (If you have some big pictures of the creatures this can help start discussions).
3. The group then need to make a large creature using all the children.
4. All the groups need to perform their creature to the other groups to see if everyone else can guess what they are.
